

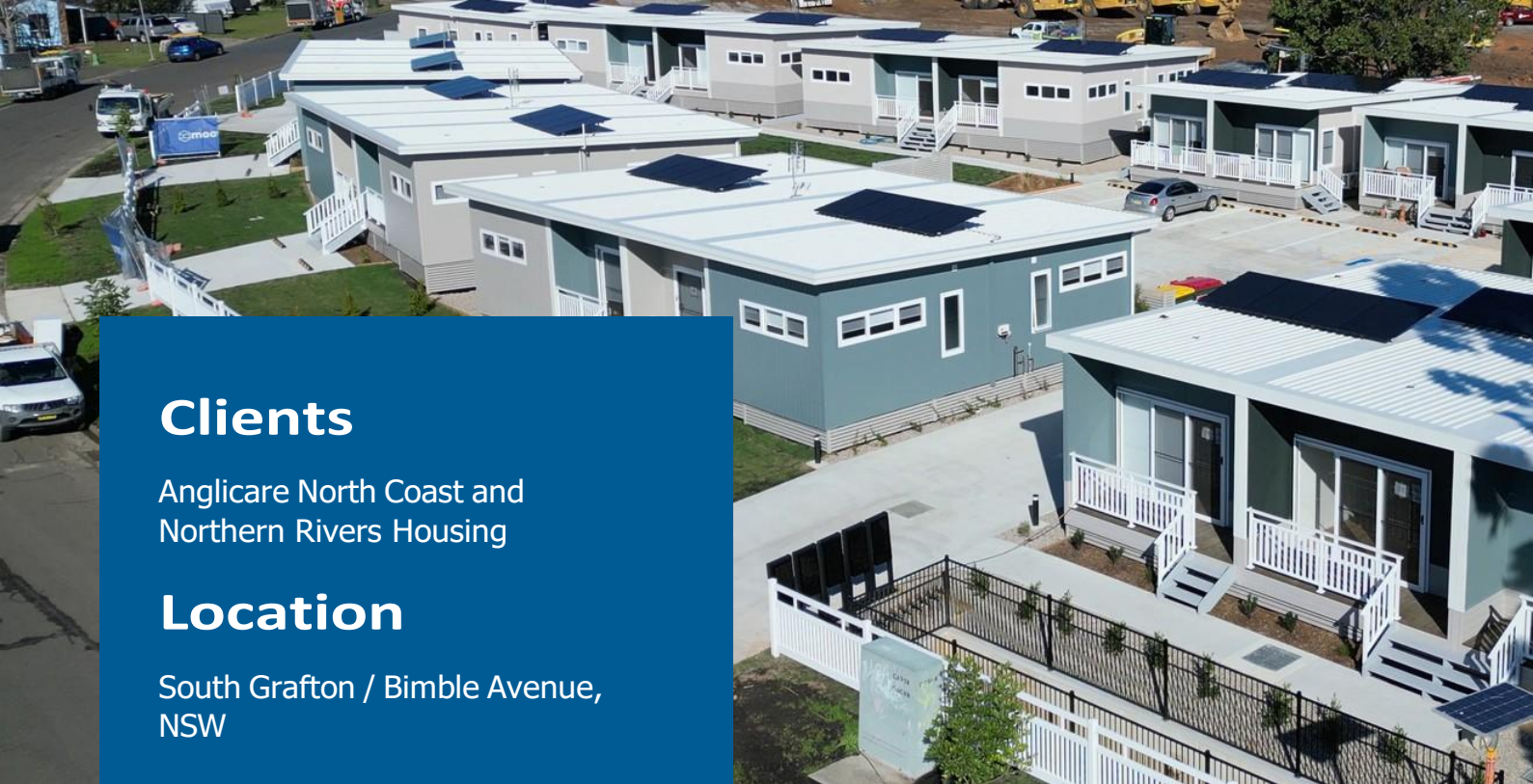

Delivering Hope at Speed and Scale

Moov Modular collaborated with Anglicare North Coast and Northern Rivers Housing to deliver 24 modular homes — a mix of 1- and 2-bedroom units — in South Grafton, NSW. As the largest modular social housing project in NSW to date, this project demonstrates how modern methods of construction can address the housing crisis with unprecedented speed, cost-effectiveness, and social impact.

In a region already grappling with a national housing crisis — compounded by the devastating impacts of recent natural disasters — this project provided urgently needed, high-quality housing for low-income earners. It's proof that housing can be delivered faster, smarter, and with lasting social impact.

This development is the largest of its kind in NSW, offering housing to families from a 10-year waiting list in Clarence Valley, where rental vacancy is under 0.9% and over 500 households are on the waitlist.

Why Modular Was the Right Solution



Speed

Factory-built modules and parallel site prep cut delivery time massively.

- Traditional build time - 18-24 months
- Moov Modular delivery - 6 months (200% faster)
- Time savings - 12-18 months per project, enabling faster relief for housing waiting lists



The Financial Advantage

Almost 20% cost reduction compared to traditional construction methods.

- \$375,000 average cost per unit vs. industry standard \$450,000+
- Total project savings - \$1.8M+ compared to conventional delivery
- 30% lower maintenance costs due to standardised components and superior build quality



Risk Mitigation

- Weather-independent construction - 80% of build occurs in controlled environment
- Supply chain resilience - Established supplier relationships and material forecasting
- Performance warranty - 10-year structural warranty on all modular components



Environmental Benefits

- 40% reduction in construction waste compared to traditional builds
- 25% improvement in energy efficiency through precision manufacturing
- Lower carbon footprint - Optimised transport logistics and minimal on-site disruption
- All homes built with a 7-star NatHERS rating as a baseline, and purpose-built to meet or potentially exceed that standard



Social Value

- With severe housing demand in the Clarence Valley, this development delivered stability, safety, and energy-efficient living for vulnerable residents
- Many of the residents were prioritised from a decade-long waitlist and have now moved in to their new homes
- Demonstrates a step toward ending the long-term social housing backlog in the area and a strong model for replication



Community Connection

- Participation from a number of inmates from Clarence Correctional Centre, delivering 2,300+ hours of in-kind labour (landscaping, fencing, trade tasks), highlights meaningful rehabilitation and local and inclusive community engagement
